

<u>Criteria applied by the Economic Committee for distributing grants among the bachelor's</u> <u>degrees of the Faculty of Arts (FA)</u>

Activities:

- Departments of the FA involved in the organisation: 1 point per department

 FA degrees they are responsible for, with the approval of the corresponding bachelor's degree coordinator (BDC):

1 point: 1 degree2 points: 2 degrees

o 3 points: 3 or more degrees

- Days /hours:

o 1 point: less than 4 hours

o 2 points: between 4 and 8 hours

o 3 points: more than 8 hours

- Speakers (not accumulative, maximum score).

1 point: URV teaching staff

o 2 points: non-URV speakers from Spain

3 points: non-URV speakers from other countries

Study trips:

- Number of students registered on the subject:

o Up to 20: 1 point

o Between 21 and 50: 2 points

o More than 50: 3 points

- Degrees involved, with the approval of the corresponding BDC:

1 point: 1 degree2 points: 2 degrees

o 3 points: 3 or more degrees

Distance:

 \circ 1 point: up to 100 km

o 2 points: between 100 and 200 km

o 3 points: more than 200 km

General conditions:

- All applications must be approved by the BDC of the degree programme responsible for organisation and the BDC of the degree programmes which they are for.
- All applications must be 50% cofinanced.
- All applications must include a detailed budget (income and expenses).
- Grants awarded for activities must be spent for the benefit of the activities. Grants awarded for trips must be spent proportionally for the benefit of both students and lecturers.
- All materials and activities must make specific mention of the Faculty or include the logo.
